Outpatient counselling services are available to individuals (adults, children, youth, family and friends) seeking help in overcoming problems associated with substance use or gambling.

Addictions Outpatient Treatment involves:

- Counselling
- Screening and assessment
- Treatment planning and goal setting
- Referral to detox and/or residential treatment when appropriate
- Pre and post counselling for individuals attending detox and residential addictions programs
- Relapse prevention skills training
- Referral to community programs

All services are person-centered, involving individuals in all stages of treatment planning and decision-making.
