3.0 Executive Elections -

Current (2021/2022): Tyne Lunn (Chair), Emily Smith (Vice Chair), Kim Gagnon (Secretary), Christine Findlay (Treasurer)

- **Call for Nominations** Tyne corresponded with Kim & Emily prior to the mtg and both agreed to let names stand for Exec if no one else willing/wanting the roles
 - Emily notes that she does not have capacity to routinely stand in as Chair, can be available as support if she continues in the Vice Chair role
- Tyne nominates Emily Smith as Vice Chair and Kim Gangon as Secretary
- Emily agrees to let name stand for Vice Chair
- Kim agrees to let name stand for Secretary
- No additional nominations, no contestment, roles stand uncontested
- Tyne desires to step down from Chair role will work with Jon to find replacement; Tyne's replacement efforts will not be indefinite
- Tyne nominates Christine Findlay as Treasurer; Christine agrees no additional nominations, role stands uncontested

4.0 Principal's Report

- Future plan/format
 - Plan to have hybrid option for mtgs moving forward; including agenda & Principal's report in digital format (hyperlinked)
 - Set up Googleclassroom standard meet for School Council
- Hot lunch
 - (3-5 years) Longer Term Vision of school-wide FREE lunch program for students; working with Wanda Laurin & food animators; grant from Peavy Mart; goals of partnering with farmer for cows, farm to table plan; interim make changes to Hot Lunch Program
 - Current order from town, pre-prepared meals
 - Proposal charge flat rate \$5, serve it "family servings, familystyle"; need support from parents to help serve; desire for 5 days a week
 - Tyne role for students to help with serving? Jon says yes with some serving training, will still need parent help
 - Punch Cards, Parents pay online, ability to donate for students in need, supported by nutritional grant
 - Council in full support of moving forward with
 - Tyne diversify holidays that get celebrated; expand to other cultures, not isolated to Christian Holiday meals

5.0 New Business - Jon requests practice of deferring any new business that comes up during mtg time to next mtg, allowing time for preparedness to consider agenda items

• Phone Policy (Christine Findlay)





- Concerns over students being on devices; need to enhance social skills; online safety; inadvertent/non-consenting exposure to inappropriate content;
- Tyne asks if there is any current device policy? Considerations for burden of teacher enforcement.
- Stephanie will removing phones increase social interaction?
- Jon unpacks existing device policy:
 - Current: Gr % not allowed personal devices in classrooms. Gr % teachers choice.
 - Philosophy "how do we model responsibility with tech?"
 - Concerns over incorporating into policy how do you police?
 - Jon acknowledges concerns over loss of social connectedness opportunities & risk of exposure are valid
 - School Efforts to enhance social connections
 - Project Peace
 - Athletics
 - Arts & Journaling
 - Additional programs
 - QSA/GSA
 - Christine proposes "digital–only" time; council not in favor of enhancing policy at this time
 - Jon reaffirms challenges of policing behaviours, burden on teachers
 - Current Digital Citizenship lessons
 - Alternately to device policy change teachers seek opportunities enhance value of connection, socializing, belonging culture
- "Shipping" TikTok Tyne raised awareness, incorporated in general device usage/safety conversation
- School Ventilation HEPA in classrooms (Tyne) can schools/classroom have HEPA air filtration devices in them?
 - Moïse will ask Board if parents or community members can donate HEPA filtration devices
 - o Jon inquires about sustainability pieces to idea





■ Tyne suggests CR Boxes as student projects? Incorporate into science curricula.
