## **School Cash Accounts**



If there are any fees for your child, such as Hockey, Dance & Gymnastics, Yearbook, damaged or lost school textbooks/replacement lock, they will appear on your SchoolCash account. Please take the time to set up your SchoolCash account and make any outstanding fee payments. You will find the easy sign-up on the Peace River School Division's website, the waffle buttons on the upper right-hand corner and selecting School Cash Online Payments (Instructions Page on page 3). You may go to your SchoolCash account and purchase your 10-punch Lunch Card(s) for \$60 each through your SchoolCash account as well.

SPECIAL NOTICE:

The following fees have been added to SchoolCash accounts: Golf Zones, Hockey Academy, Gymnastics Academy, Volleyball, Lock replacements (lost item \$10). Please make your payment as soon as possible as we need to pay for tournament fees. Thank you so much for your patience & understanding.



#### HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

You may now purchase a \$60 Lunch card (\$6 per meal for 10 lunches) through your SchoolCash Account (instructions on page 3). The lunch card will be recorded /tracked in a google document here at the school this will alleviate any lost cards.

Students will come to the Home Ec. window to pick up their lunch based

on which lunch they would like; you do not have to purchase every day. Students will be told when they have two lunches remaining on their card and they will need to let you know you so you can purchase an additional Lunch Card. The following is the menu:

# How to add children to your account

- From the dropdown menu, select My Students.
- Click to add a child:

  - Choose your school from the list.
  - Enter your child's details. You may add up to 8 students to your account.
  - Click Confirm.

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# SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

Ensuring that Peace River School Division students get to and from school safely is very important to me. Each year, our students and bus drivers take part in safety training to ensure that, if an unfortunate event takes place, every person on the bus remains safe until they arrive either back at home or at one of our schools.

During the last school year, our division had two near misses involving our busses. These near misses happened because people were simply not paying attention to our busses. It is the responsibility of all drivers to know the laws and drive with extreme caution when approaching a school bus, from either direction.

A bus driver will always signal to drivers that the bus will soon stop to load or unload children by activating the overhead alternating **AMBER** lights. When the bus stops and the driver opens the door, the overhead alternating **RED** lights and side stop arm are activated. When you see this, it can mean only one thing – there are children either walking onto, or walking off of, a bus. All drivers approaching the bus from either direction must come to a complete stop.

Passing a bus when the red lights are flashing and the side stop arm is activated is both illegal and potentially deadly.

Thankfully, our near misses were not more tragic accidents, and this is in part because of the extreme professionalism of our drivers. The PRSD is grateful to have such a skilled team of drivers and driver trainers.

Most of our drivers were trained by one of our three Class 2 Driver Trainers: Amber Johner, Pearl Campbell and Lesli Mitchell. Together, these three women make up phenomenal team with decades of professional driving experience between them.

When a person applies to become a new driver, they only require a Class 5 license because Amber, Pearl or Lesli take care of making sure each new driver is properly trained and can successfully obtain their Class 2 license. This training is always provided by the division at no cost to the applicant.

If driving a school bus sounds interesting to you, then we have a place for you on our team. We are always looking for more bus drivers, both as regular drivers and spare drivers. This rewarding career suits a broad category of people, from stay-at-home parents to grandparents, educational assistants, and so many other types of people with flexible schedules.
