


# TA NORRIS MIDDLE SCHOOL





We're wrapping up our second week back at school, and what a great start it's been!


The energy in the building is inspiring, with students settling into routines, engaging in learning, and reconnecting with friends and staff. It's already shaping up to be a fantastic year!




