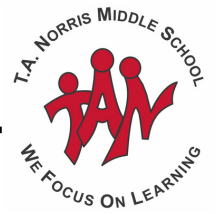




TA NORRIS MIDDLE SCHOOL

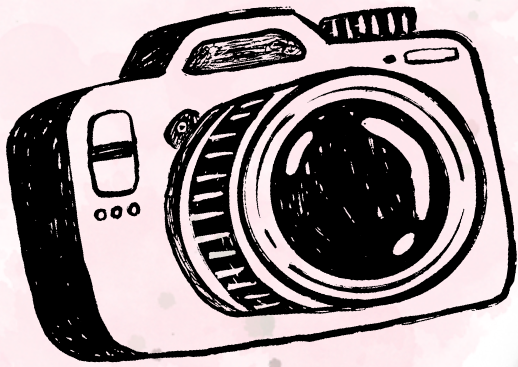

October is our **FREE TRY-IT** month

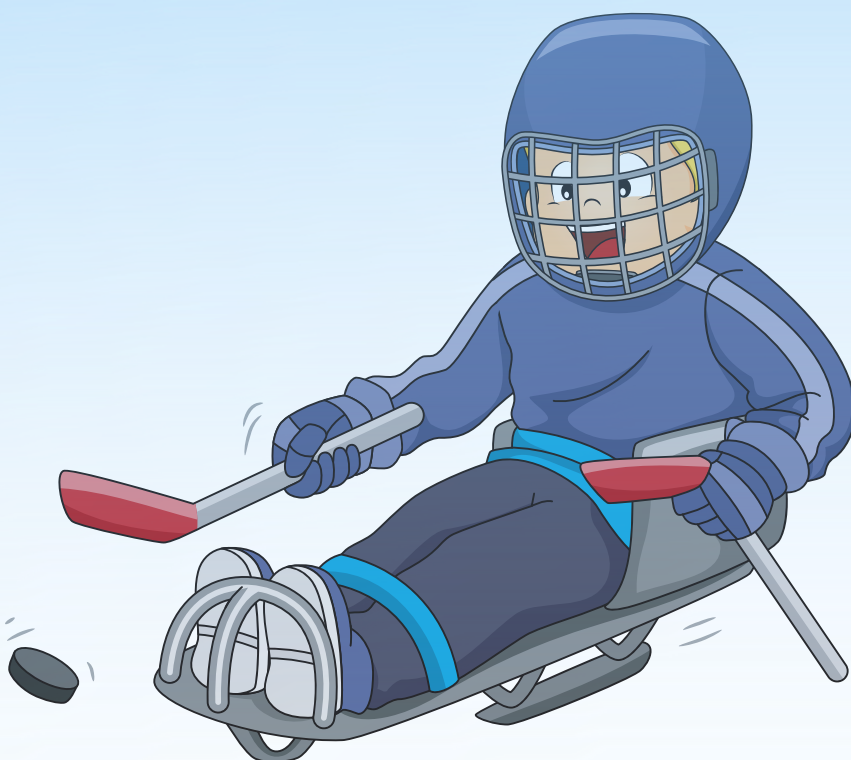
Come check out sledge hockey, an inclusive program for all ages and abilities. Equipment provided, just bring a hockey helmet and gloves if you have them.
